OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Hon'ble Commission vide its Tariff Order dated 10-04-2010 at Annexure-10(A) (12) has allowed Single Point Bulk Supply for Domestic, Non-domestic and Mixed Load categories. The following is provided in the Tariff Order in the matter:

- "(i) Domestic / Non-domestic-Buildings / Malls / Cooperative Group Housing Societies / Colonies having total load above 50 kW can avail connection at single point with single point metering for further distribution. However, this shall not restrict the individual owner/occupier from applying for individual connection.
- (ii) The person who has taken the single point supply shall be responsible for all payments of electricity charges to the licensee and collection from the end consumer as per applicable tariff for them.
- (iii) The person who has taken the single point supply shall also be deemed to be an agent of Licensee to undertake distribution of electricity for the premises for which single point supply is given under seventh proviso to section 14 of the Electricity Act, 2003 and distribution licensee shall be responsible for compliance of all provisions of the Act and Rules & Regulations thereunder within such area."
2. Accordingly, the person who has been allowed single point supply as mentioned above shall be the consumer of UPCL and simultaneously will also act as an agent of UPCL for further distribution of electricity to the end consumers. To perform the act of agent, such person shall be required to enter into an agency agreement with UPCL in addition to the supply agreement which is required to be entered for supply of electricity. The format of such agency agreement is enclosed herewith.

**FORMAT OF AGREEMENT OF AGENCY FOR  
DISTRIBUTION OF ELECTRICITY**

(To be typed on stamp paper of Rs. 100)

This agreement is made on this \_\_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_\_ month of 20\_\_ (year) at \_\_\_\_\_ between Uttarakhand Power Corporation Limited, a company incorporated under the Indian Companies Act, 1956, having its Registered office at Urja Bhawan, Kanwali Road, Dehradun granted a Licence by Uttarakhand Electricity Regulatory Commission for carrying on the business of Distribution and Retail supply of electricity energy in the State of Uttarakhand (hereinafter referred to as "PRINCIPAL" which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include its successors and assigns), of the one part and Mr./Ms./Mrs. \_\_\_\_\_ applicant/authorized signatory for and on behalf of M/s \_\_\_\_\_, a company incorporated under the Indian Company Act, 1956 / a sole proprietorship / partnership firm or any other establishment having its Registered Office at \_\_\_\_\_ (hereinafter referred to as "AGENT" which expression shall unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, include its successors and permitted assigns) and collectively referred to as "Parties".

- (A) Whereas the AGENT has been sanctioned a single point electrical connection of ..... KW at (full address) \_\_\_\_\_ partly for his own use and partly for distribution in the building / mall / Cooperative Group / Housing Society / Colony located at the same address.
- (B) Whereas the AGENT has entered into an agreement with UPCL on ..... (date) for supply of electricity as sanctioned to him.
- (C) The AGENT has requested to PRINCIPAL, under the seventh proviso to section-14 of the Electricity Act, 2003 to authorise him to undertake distribution of electricity for the premises as mentioned at para (A) above from the electricity connection as sanctioned to him and the PRINCIPAL has agreed to authorise to the AGENT for such distribution of electricity on the terms and conditions hereinafter contained.
- (D) And whereas this agreement shall be deemed to have been effective from the ....., which date shall be construed as the date of commencement of agency under this agreement.

**NOW IT IS HEREBY DECLARED AND AGREED AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The AGENT shall make his own arrangement at his own cost for distribution of electricity in the premises.
2. The AGENT shall be responsible for all payments of electricity charges to the PRINCIPAL. He shall also be responsible for metering, billing and collection from the end consumers as per applicable tariff on each of such consumers.
3. The AGENT shall strictly comply with the provisions of Electricity Act, 2003, rules and regulations made thereunder and Distribution and Retail Supply Licence issued to the PRINCIPAL and directions issued by PRINCIPAL, while performing his duties as an agent as per this agreement.
